Swift Observation of long GRB 090107A

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1 Introduction

BAT triggered on GRB 090107A at 04:48:04 UT (Trigger 339295) (Ukwatta, et al., GCN Circ. 8782). This was a 1.024 sec rate-trigger on a long burst with $T90 = 12.2 \pm 0.7$ sec. Swift could not slew to this burst due to its proximity to the Sun.

Our best position is the BAT ground-calculated location $RA(J2000) = 302.409 \deg(20h09m38.2s)$, $Dec(J2000) = +4.744 \deg(+04d44'37.9'')$ with an uncertainty of 2.4 arcsec (90% confidence, including boresight uncertainties), reported by Sato *et al.*, *GCN Circ.* 8783.

Since, Swift did not slew to the BAT position, there are no XRT or UVOT data for this trigger.

2 BAT Observation and Analysis

Using the data set from T-240 to $T+962\,\mathrm{sec}$, further analysis of BAT GRB 090107A has been performed by BAT team (Sato, et al., GCN Circ. 8783). The BAT ground-calculated position is $\mathrm{RA}(J2000)=302.409\,\mathrm{deg}$ (20h09m38.2s), $\mathrm{Dec}(J2000)=4.744\,\mathrm{deg}$ (+04d44'37.9") \pm 2.4 arcmin, (radius, systematic and statistical, 90% containment). The partial coding was 74% (the bore sight angle was 22.5 deg).




Figure 1: The mask-weighted light curve in the 4 individual plus total energy bands. The units are counts/sec/illuminated-detector and T_0 is 04:48:04 UT.

The mask-weighted light curve (Fig. 1) shows two peaks. The first is about 1.2 sec wide and peaks at $\sim T+0.9$ sec. The second is about 6 sec wide and peaks at $\sim T+11$ sec. Because of the Sun observing constraint and because of a regular pre-planned target slew, the BAT has no data on this event past T+260 sec. T90 (15 -350 keV) is 12.2 ± 0.7 sec (estimated error including systematics).

The time-averaged spectrum from T+0.2 to T+12.9 sec is best fit by a simple power-law model. The power law index of the time-averaged spectrum is 1.69 ± 0.27 . The fluence in the 15-150 keV band is $2.3 \pm 0.5 \times 10^{-7} \rm erg \, cm^{-2}$. The 1-sec peak photon flux measured from T+0.30 sec in the 15-150 keV band is 1.1 ± 0.2 ph/cm2/sec. All the quoted errors are at the 90% confidence level.
